Arms or Human Rights?

We monitor the export of arms from the Czech Republic. Our aim is to prevent Czech Republic from supporting dictatorial regimes, military juntas, escalation of military conflicts, oppressive regimes as well as countries liaison transfer countries for further re-export of the weaponry or arms by exporting weapons into these regions. We campaign for the Czech foreign policy to be responsible, transparent and put forward the human rights to financial interests.

Thanks to PEACEcamp – a week lasting meeting of Czech, Slovak and Swedish teams, we issued a guide Arms Trade for Beginners. We organized protests against the IDET – International Trade Fair of Defence and Security Technologies. We participated in Salina T3 (Tram T3) for better climate, justice and decent work – because we believe a better world is possible without weapons. Together with NaZemi we have created an interactive tutorial program Zero-Sum Game on the context of armed conflicts for the young people over 16.

Support Animal Rights

We focus primarily on factory farming of animals. We aspire to change European legislature and to improve living conditions of these animals so they would not suffer on either physically or mentally. We promote alternative, animal-products-free methods of diets.

We have started cooperation with organizations Compassion in World Farming and Society for Animals and we have also joined their Europe-wide End the Cage Age campaign. The goal of the campaign in 2015 was to end cage breeding of farm animals in European Union. We started working on campaigns I Do Not Eat Mass Bred Animals and Eggs From Cage.
